Intermediate/Junior & Youth– access to the course on any day of the week, with reduced annual fees depending on age and employment status.

Social Membership – no golf included, Green Fees are applicable should you choose to play on any day of the week.

Country Membership – for members, whose main residence is in excess of 75 miles away from Chobham Golf Club. Country Members are entitled to 12 rounds of Golf per year.

Corporate Membership – for Companies, 8 transferable rounds per month. Restricted playing times.

Other Useful Information

What to expect when you join Chobham Golf Club?

A common worry for many golfers joining a new club is “Will I fit in?”, or “Will I make new friends and quickly find like-minded people to play golf with?” That need not concern as we think of Chobham as Surrey’s friendliest club, and for good reason.

We encourage all new members to enter the many and varied competitions on offer, not just to gain or maintain an active handicap, but to meet and get to know other members. Whether you are a low or high handicapper, you will be able to enjoy a full range of both competitive and social golf. If you have an active handicap, you can immediately fully participate in club activities. If not, then it’s a simple matter, depending on your handicap status, of either playing in three qualifying competitions or submitting three score cards to the Handicaps committee.

Notice sheets or entry sheets for all upcoming competitions are posted on one of the notice boards up to 6 weeks in advance. These include monthly weekend and midweek medals and a monthly Sunday mixed competition, for which advance sign-up is required. There are in addition monthly roll-up competitions, for which no advance sign-up is required, including weekend and midweek Stablefords and a Monday Texas Scramble, which is good fun. In order to maintain a balance of competitive and social golf, Men, Ladies, and Juniors sections have a maximum of two qualifying weekend competitions per month, normally one medal and one Stableford. We also hold summer and winter knock out competitions, and a variety of honours board events throughout the year.

In addition, you will have the opportunity to be selected to represent the Club in a variety of Mens, Ladies and Mixed inter club matches. Men may also play inter club matches for the Tigers (handicaps up to 14), Rabbits (handicaps over 15) or Seniors (aged 55 and over).

And last but not least, do not be shy about just turning up on a weekend morning and asking to join in. The office staff and the organisers of the various sections and competitions will be happy to assist you in meeting other members.

You can be assured of a warm and friendly welcome at Chobham Golf Club.

Members Levy Card Scheme

It is a requirement of all members to join the club's member's levy card scheme, which entitles you to a discount whenever you use the bar, catering facilities or pay for guest green fees. The discount is 15%, which is given at the time of purchase.

The 2019/2020 card scheme advance payment requirement is £150 (Social £75, Social Gold £200). Top up payments, of any value, can be made at any time in the bar or Pro-shop.

Members are required to make the Annual payment in September (by 1st October) each year.

Aside from the advantages of getting more for your money when you use your card, you will have no need to carry cash.

Please note, the only time that you cannot use your card, is when paying for functions/parties.

Final Information

For the enjoyment of everyone, we respectfully ask that all players adhere to our dress code at all times

On the Course

(including the putting green and practice ground)

- No jeans, denim or tracksuits allowed
- Caps to be worn with peaks forward
- Shirts must be tucked into trousers or shorts and must have a collar
- T-shirts, beachwear, rugby or football shirts are not acceptable
- Casual cargo/multi-pocketed type trousers or shorts are not permitted
- When worn with shorts, socks or ankle socks should be predominately white (unless knee length)
- Trousers must not be tucked into socks
- Golf shoes only – soft spikes preferred

Ladies only

- Tailored waist length golf shirts or blouses may be worn over trousers, shorts, skirts or skorts

In the Clubhouse

(including the patio)

- Clean, presentable denim jeans may be worn in the clubhouse (not ripped or distressed)
- Clean golf footwear may be worn anywhere in the clubhouse but golf shoes that have metal or soft spikes can ONLY be worn in the “Spikes Bar” area
- Trainers or open toed sandals may be worn anywhere in the clubhouse
- Beach flip-flops and crocs are unacceptable
- No caps or hats to be worn in the clubhouse
- Men’s collared shirts should be worn and should be tucked in
- T-shirts, track suits, beachwear, rugby or football shirts are not acceptable
- Wet and muddy clothing or footwear is not acceptable
- Socks are not compulsory
- Trousers must not be tucked into socks
- Industrial work clothing is considered unacceptable in the bar and restaurant area unless such attire is being worn to perform a role in which the individual has been engaged in by the club

Mobile Phones

Mobile devices should not be used in the clubhouse for receiving or making calls except for emergencies. Mobile devices can be used for photography/recording videos, receiving or making text messages and internet usage provided the device used is on silent.
